4. For the literature sponsorship which allows us to give a Bible or a Christian magazine to those who ask for them.
5. For the opportunity to use our experience and local knowledge to help other groups to achieve their own objectives here.

#### Please pray ...

1. That the heavy snow and cold weather this winter will lead to a better growing season during the coming year, and that food supplies will return to normal.
2. For the increasing number of people are asking for help on a regular basis whilst the plight of the poor continues to slip further behind acceptable standards.
3. For those who have accepted Bibles or Christian literature during the year, that spiritual seeds may be sown and their interest will grow.
4. For those whose needs we cannot meet.
5. That the new Romanian government will recognise all its responsibilities to the nation and its people, and that it will not be distracted by political agenda or by personal ambition.
