Give thanks ...

1. For goods to the value of £8,000 given out through the office last month.
2. Food is still expensive at this time of year and we are thankful for the supplies and sponsorship that AN has received during the past few months, and which have allowed us to continue to help those in need.
3. The weather is starting to warm up and the need for heating is declining. Construction and other outdoor activities are starting to be active again and this provides more opportunities for casual labour and the chance to earn a little money.

Please pray ...

1. An issue has arisen with the copyright of the Bibles that we give to those who request them. This may reduce the availability of one of the versions that we use.
2. For those who have land, the soil will soon be ready for planting. This means investing in the costs and effort of ploughing and seeding, but there will be no return on this investment until the harvest starts to come in.
3. Many families have accumulated large electricity bills during the winter - some have no hope of paying and will incur severe penalties and loss of future supply.
4. Please continue to pray for the 3 special situations that we described last month - Maria Coropca, Fani Cojocariu and Iulian Horodincu.

1. For continuing financial support, not in excess but just enough to demonstrate God's constant provision for this work.
2. For the regular supply of clothing and other items which allows us to maintain the supply of help to those in need.
3. For several new enquiries and offers of goods from 'first-time' donors during the past month.
4. For the harmony and fellowship that we enjoy as we work together to prepare the donated items for storage and dispatch.

Please pray ...

1. For the two teams planning to visit Dorohoi later this year, from Horley at the beginning of May and from Tollesbury later in that month.
2. For the lorries being loaded in March and April in Wales, and from Billingshurst in May. Pray for guidance in the choice of items to send, a good turnout for the actual loading and safety for the vehicles en route.
3. For the harp recital next weekend. Pray for the encouragement of a good turnout and an increase in the level of interest in the work that we do.
4. That the anti-Romanian stance of sections of the UK press will not discourage people from helping to sustain needy Romanians who stay in their own country.
5. For the spiritual dimension of the work in the UK - how we relate to those with whom we come into contact and how we demonstrate God's love in action.
