4. For the forthcoming visit by a team from Essex supporting the work of the Centre of Hope.
5. That the outcomes of these visits in people's lives will enable God to continue his work through RoAF, AN and the Centre of Hope. Pray that God will renew our strength as we seek to follow His plans for His work in this area.
