It is now 3 years since the floods that devastated much of Dorohoi. Some households have still not recovered from the effects of losing almost all they had. In one instance, a couple and their two grandchildren were moved into a council flat but they were not given any way to provide for their other needs. As grandparents, they cannot even claim the children's allowance. They now have an outstanding electricity bill of over £1,200 and cannot move elsewhere until that is settled.

Give thanks ...

1. For continuing sponsorship for many families and individuals. This support is a lifeline to those who benefit from designated gifts of food, clothing or money and in many cases it has resulted in a complete turnaround in their circumstances.
2. For the end of another school year, for those children who have passed another milestone on their way to maturity and thereby improved their future prospects.

Please pray ...

1. For those children whose prospects are blighted by poor school facilities, official indifference or difficult home circumstances.
2. For those who have finished their education and are now venturing into the adult world, especially those being discharged from care institutions because they have reached the age of 18 and who now have to learn to look after themselves.

2. That the Horley team will be able to continue its weekly packing sessions during the transition to new premises. A parallel problem is finding a new location for the shed that is used for the storage of goods prior to packing and dispatch.
3. That more people will be willing to get involved in the day-to-day activities of each of our teams, sharing the work and enjoying the pleasure of helping others.
4. That those who have dealings with us, whether as donors or beneficiaries, will recognise that the achievements of the charity are not just human effort but rather a reflection of God's concern for each one of us.
