In addition to all its normal activities, AN was involved in three concurrent building projects last month. Sponsorship from the UK has covered most of the cost for materials and labour, but it was a particularly busy time for the AN team.

This is traditionally the time for the small-scale family farmers to start bringing in the harvest. Autumn has arrived early and a severe winter is forecast so the task has a particular urgency this year.

1. For safe arrival of the team from west Wales and the good progress that they have made on the construction of the house for the Andrisan family in Saucenita.
2. For the substantial completion of a new home for Elena Balan. She was made homeless in the 2010 floods and has been living in temporary accommodation.
3. For the safe arrival of a delivery of aid from west Wales, including 56 boxes of mixed food donated by customers of Morrisons in Aberystwyth.

Please pray ...

1. For those people whose survival is linked to the crops that they can gather now.
2. For wisdom for the AN team, in balancing the competing demands that it faces.
3. For those who have started coming to church as a result of their contact with AN - that they may come to recognise that “man does not live by bread alone”.

1. For the team preparing the lorry from Swansea on 21st October; for a good turn-out of willing hands, safety in the task and good passage for the vehicle.
2. For the current Christmas gift appeal - these gifts are still much appreciated by the recipient and we need to send about 3,000 boxes to avoid disappointment.
3. For those talking about the work of RoAF and AN in the next few months, that their enthusiasm will bring about an increase in interest and support for the positive achievements in Romania.
4. For the continuity of financial support for RoAF - this is an expensive time of year and people have other commitments, but God is able to provide.
