December has been relatively dry and warm - on average some 15C warmer than the corresponding period for last year. Whilst this makes for lower heating costs and easier travel, it is not entirely good news. A certain amount of snow and sub-zero temperatures are necessary for proper growing conditions later in the year.

Including the Christmas gift boxes, AN gave donations of goods exceeding £17,400 to some 480 households, individuals and organisations during December.

Give thanks ...

1. For the supporters' visit in December, when our visitors were able to make a significant contribution to the distribution of shoeboxes in local schools.
2. For the continuing support that we receive from the UK and local donations in Romania which allow AN to continue providing help for those in need.
3. For good working relationships locally throughout the past year.

Please pray ...

1. For this year's harvest - a dry winter often leads to a water shortage and poor crops during the summer months.
2. About the mounting costs of running AN's vehicles; although not old by Romanian standards, they are both suffering from the severe operating conditions here.
3. That the spiritual dimension of our work will remain prominent in our activities

3. For the timely provision of financial resources throughout 2013 and the efforts of many people which allowed so many needs to be met.
4. For the generosity of those who prepared Christmas gift boxes; in particular for the increase in both quantity and quality of the gift boxes.
5. For those who have sponsored particular individuals or families during the past year, often at significant personal cost and inconvenience.

Please pray ...

1. That God will protect those who work in or visit the warehouses that we use in Billingshurst and near Swansea, and overrule concerning the safe keeping of the goods that have been entrusted into our care .
2. For those of our supporters who are suffering from illness, whether seasonal or more long-term - may God grant them peace and comfort.
3. That the new year will bring a better understanding and sympathy for needy people in Romania, and that more people will be willing to help them to rebuild their country and society.
4. For the opportunities of the new year and the situations that we will face.
