January started dry and warm - some 20C warmer than usual - but winter arrived in the middle of the month, bringing many parts of the county to a halt with snow drifts more than seven feet deep. This ended the complacency of the town dwellers about lower heating costs and the concern of the rural folk about the lack of sufficient precipitation. Temperatures are typically -8C at night and the requests for fuel and food have multiplied. Unfortunately none of these resources is infinite and some rationing is necessary prior to the arrival of the next lorry.

1. For those asking for Bibles - the level of interest continues grow. Recipients are being invited to a special outreach at Dorohoi Baptist Church later this month.
2. For the 'baby-bags' - knitted blankets and clothing and other essentials which are being distributed in the local maternity unit as well as to callers at the office.

1. For Cristina (19); she grew up in an orphanage and now finds herself 'with child' and without much else. In the absence of adequate family support she relies upon AN for many necessities.
2. For those people who are short of food or fuel, or have to work outside during this wintry period, and those suffering ill-health exacerbated by the cold weather.
