The border with Ukraine is only some 15 miles from Dorohoi and many of AN's beneficiaries live much closer than that. This border area has not been affected by the unrest elsewhere in Ukraine but if the hostilities escalate to the point that local people feel threatened then it is likely that many may feel safer in Romania. These refugees would place additional stains on local relief activities, including those of AN. As with previous emergencies here, God will provide the necessary resources at the right time - we just need to be ready to be His channels.

1. For the recent consignment of clothing, bedding and other items received last month, including sponsored boxes for families and sweets and outfits from Tesco.
2. For the 3-dozen or so baby bags and blankets that have been given to young mums in Dorohoi maternity unit.
3. For continuing good co-operation with local officials and other local charities.

1. For the arrangements for the teenage camp later in the summer.
2. For those who attended the outreach meetings at Dorohoi Baptist Church last month, especially those of our beneficiaries who showed particular interest.
3. For health and strength for the AN team, and our witness to our beneficiaries.

2. That donor interest will be maintained into the new season and that God will continue to overrule in the provision of finance and human resources.
3. For visits to Dorohoi being planned for later this year.
