Fuel and energy prices have risen again this month. This has serious implications for those who cannot pay these prices and we anticipate an increase in the number of households appealing for help in meeting their bills. One effect of this is to make people try to find other sources of heating. Those who can do so are already preparing their firewood for next winter but many others will be reduced to scavenging for domestic or commercial waste to burn. The environmental consequences of increasing deforestation include soil erosion and flash flooding, both of which affect the poorer rural communities disproportionately.

The Swansea team reports an extremely busy first half-year, with generous donations of clothing and household items. Some items are not priorities for the households in Romania so these are sold for recycling or offered at car boot sales. The team has attended 17 boot sales so far this year and the proceeds are used to help to finance the lorries that they send.

The Horley team is reviewing its warehousing arrangements, with the objective of finding premises nearer to home. This will reduce operating costs and allow the team to maintain day-to-day activities without the need to travel so much.

1. For the abundant supply of good quality items being offered to our teams.
2. For financing for the lorry from Swansea later this month. The lorry is full and preparation of the next load is underway.
3. For a recent contact offering help for babies and young mums.

Please pray ...

1. For the home teams, who are preparing the donated items for dispatch; for safety in their activities and encouragement in their work.
2. For those planning to visit Dorohoi in the next few months - especially that they will return home with renewed enthusiasm.
3. For decisions concerning the future warehousing needs for the Horley team.
4. That more people will be willing to get involved in the day-to-day activities of each of our teams, sharing the work and enjoying the pleasure of helping others.
