- 1. For a substantial reduction in the rent for the Billingshurst warehouse, which will allow normal operations to resume in September.
- 2. For offers of funding for lorries in September and November.
- 3. For renewed encouragement amongst our teams.
- 4. For the confirmation from God that our work should continue.

Please pray ...

- 1. For an increase in the committed regular income, so that future activities can be planned with confidence.
- 2. For additional, preferably younger, people to recognise the vision of our work and become actively involved on a regular basis.
- 3. For the Christmas gift box distribution some boxes have already arrived in Dorohoi but we need many more in order to avoid disappointment.
- 4. That spiritual essentials will not be swamped by temporal needs.
