We praise God for the amount of help that we were able to give to people last year. During 2014, AN received goods to the value of some £85,000 from RoAF. Adding this to the stock remaining from 2013 and donations from other sources gave assets equivalent to some £106,300. Of this, just over 12% was transferred to the shop whilst clothing, food and other items to the value of approximately £73,300 were given to a total of 1,380 people asking for help. The shop raised sufficient income to cover AN's operating costs plus an additional 23% which was given as cash donations to needy households, to help with rent, fuel bills, medical costs and similar domestic emergencies. On behalf of all our beneficiaries we want to thank all those whose generosity made all this possible.
