This, of course, only offers hope to those who are able-bodied and can find employment. For many households, that is not the case and at this time of year we receive many appeals from people who have nothing to eat. So far this year we have given out nearly 1 ton of food from the harvest collections and made 40 donations of money to help people buy food for their families.
