During the past month we have been distributing kindergarten equipment suitable for indoor use and each delivery is received with delight by the children (and their teachers).

2. For the safe arrival of another load of aid from west and south Wales.

Please pray ...

1. For fortitude for the AN staff whose workload intensifies at this time of year just as weather conditions deteriorate.
2. That God will continue to overrule in the plans for the boys' house, especially when considering who might live there and how they are to be managed. It is not too early to start to pray about the most challenging aspect of this project!

We can also use bulk donations of sweets, chocolates, pencils and similar smaller items which can be shared out amongst the recipients. For those who cannot prepare a box themselves, there is the option of giving a cash donation which will be used in Romania to donate a box on your behalf.

2. For successful loading at Llantrissant and for the variety of goods available.
