One of the highlights in January was the installation of a donated trampoline at Havirna kindergarten, alongside the climbing frame that RoAF team members provided in 1994. The latter is still fully serviceable and one of the teachers recalled playing on it herself as a child.

The efforts of our knitters are now proving their worth, with many families receiving blankets, scarves and gloves and, where appropriate, knitwear for children too. It is not uncommon to see children wearing these items in their classes, especially in the rural schools where the wood stoves are less efficient.

3. For good co-operation between the charities and the local social services.
