Officially, it is the beginning of Spring but, at the time of writing, the weather is cooler than a month ago. Our mountain of knitwear, built up during the summer, has diminished rapidly but we look forward to receiving more blankets, scarves, hats and other items ready for next winter.

Work has started again on the boys' house - plumbing for water distribution and drainage is well advanced and will be followed by the central heating system. Recently, a donation from a local source exactly matched an invoice received the following day - once again demonstrating God's provision for this project.

Several of our "more challenging clients" have started attending church services, often to the consternation of the existing congregation - normal church behaviour is not one of the skills acquired during an orphanage upbringing!

2. For the opportunities and resources that allow us to help with more than just clothes - last month's donations included baby baths, spectacles and crutches.

Late last year RoAF received a bequest from the estate of Silvia Wibley, a lady who is known to many of the team in Horley. The Trustees, together with friends of the benefactor, have decided that this money should best be used to purchase the freehold of the shop in Dorohoi; the lease is due to expire in April 2017. The bequest does not cover the whole amount but it is a major step towards safeguarding the future of Asociația Neemia's activities in Dorohoi.

We have started to receive the bulk donation of sanitary ware for the boys' home. The first load will be dispatched on 19th March from the Billingshurst warehouse along with clothing and other items that the team in Romania is waiting for. This will be another opportunity for our enthusiastic volunteers to help with loading.
