These visits give our supporters the opportunity to see conditions in Dorohoi and the surrounding area, and to meet some of the people that being helped by their efforts. For our part, as hosts, we are able to demonstrate in more detail how we go about helping local people. In addition the visits give us the opportunity to view their situations through our visitors' eyes and refocus on the recipients as people instead of just names on a piece of paper. We are now helping the second generation of certain households, which raises the question of whether there might be another form of help that would be more effective in the longer term.

# Prayer Notes June 2016

RoAF is essentially a faith-based organisation that relies on prayer. Below and overleaf we offer some prayer pointers, but please feel free to add your own items as they come to mind. Prayer is our connection with God's ultimate power source and, without prayer support, this work would achieve nothing of lasting value.

For the third year, sponsorship has been received which will allow about 30 children from needy families to go on a summer camp holiday in the Romanian mountains (photo). For most of these children, a holiday away from home is a rare opportunity to experience a change of scenery, meet other children and enjoy fun and games, all in a healthy Christian environment. Sponsorship is being coordinated by the RoAF team in Swansea. Further info and photos on our website. Our fourth lorry of the year is due to leave Billingshurst later this month, closely followed by one from Swansea early in July. So far this year, RoAF has sent some 37 tons of aid items having a local value in Romania of £43,000. These items (and the cost of transport) have been donated by individuals, companies and other organisations, and we thank everybody for their generosity. Included in the latest load were 25 bicycles refurbished by the residents of Cardiff prison. These bicycles are valuable for adults to get to work and help children in poorer families to feel less disadvantaged (photo).
