

# Asociația Neemia **Prayer Notes** November 2016

Typical daytime temperatures have fallen by some 30C during a period of five weeks, reminding us that Autumn can be a very short season here. Snow is forecast and it may well have arrived by the time you read this. Outside work is curtailed and casual labourers laid off. It is time to distribute the stocks of blankets and knitted garments which have accumulated during the summer and as we do so we are impressed once again by the quality of the items and the amount of effort that has gone into making them. Many thanks to all our 'Great Knits'!

It is also the time when home heating becomes a priority. Wood is the most popular heating fuel here, even for many households in the town. Some people are able to source their wood themselves and just need a bit of help in paying for it; others such as the elderly or disabled need to have firewood prepared for them. AN has once again been able to acquire a limited stock of wood and some of the young men have kept warm chopping and stacking it. Inevitably it will not be enough to satisfy all the requests and some will have to be declined.

Christmas gift boxes have started to arrive in Dorohoi. They will bring a lot of pleasure to many people but their arrival also signals a busy period for the AN team. We respect the amount of effort involved in preparing the boxes and getting them to us and we try to match the contents by age and gender to those who will receive them.

- 2. For the Johnson family visit the opportunity to see AN at work first hand and to meet the people that they have supported so generously.
- 3. A supply of firewood to help vulnerable people this winter.
