Prayer Notes August 2017

AN has acquired ownership of our shop premises in Dorohoi. A combination of bequests and donations from RoAF supporters has allowed us to redeem the freehold and thereby achieve longer-term security for the work that AN is doing. The freehold was previously offered for sale some 11 years ago, and we are grateful to Richard and Linda Burgess for stepping in to prevent a third party from taking control of the shop then.

AN has some 3,000 registered beneficiary households and distributes over 100 tons of aid each year. An operation on this scale requires staffing and facilities, and the shop is an effective way of funding AN's day to day activities. The shop also generates a surplus which is used to provide cash payments towards family expenses, such as medical costs, electricity bills, school fees, etc. In 2016 these payments averaged some £700 per month.

The shop sells a proportion of the aid items that AN receives. This proportion is governed by statute to a maximum of 15% of the value of goods received. (The actual figure for 2016 was 13%.) The shop does not sell any food, hand knitted garments or designated gifts, or any items where the donor has specifically requested direct donation. The shop is run in a professional and friendly way and has a loyal clientèle, some of whom travel from 25 miles away on "new stock" days.

The premises are also used for the sorting and packing of aid for those families who have registered their needs with AN. These packages are then transferred to the office for collection by those families. In short, the shop is an essential cog in the process of providing help to the needy, and we thank God for this step towards maintaining continuity of service.
