Changing lives, one lorry at a time.

Izabela Geodiou lives with her parents and siblings in a small village east of Dorohoi. Izabela was born with a heart defect and needs to have an operation to correct this. Thanks to the generosity of RoAF supporters, the family can afford to make the necessary arrangements and the operation is expected to take place early this month.

Education is one of the most effective ways of tackling poverty in the longer term but schools in rural areas often suffer from poor facilities and limited resources. For several years AN has been able to help many such schools with stationery, games and other materials; recently, a large donation of Lego was shared between three schools, making lessons more creative and fun, and developing skills for later life.

Marian Ciobanu is one of the boys who will probably be offered a place in Casa Neemia once it is completed. He was abandoned at birth and his life then has been one long story of being moved around and unwanted. For almost all of his life he has felt unloved and worthless. Marian likes to be useful, helping with AN's various activities or running errands, and he thinks of the AN team as his only family. He attends the simple Bible study which has been started for the 'ex-orphanage boys'.

Legislation is changing too and AN has to evolve. However, the changes are primarily administrative and, with your help, we will continue to share God's unchanging love with those in need
