This month we received some extra food and household items from a charity in the east of Romania. It was a long drive in our van to go and collect them but it was worthwhile. The goods included a large quantity of margarine which we can donate in place of the sunflower oil now that last year's crop is almost exhausted.

A letter from Ukraine Dorohoi:

"I'm Natalia, my husband is Sasha and our daughter is Sveta, we come from Ukraine from the town Zaporojie and arrived here on 30th of March.

To begin with we have not planned to evacuate our home, but when we heard about how the Russian criminals and Russian rapists commit atrocities in Ukraine and they are getting closer to Zaporojie area and so many people died in Mariupol in basements without water and food.

Then we heard that will be organised an evacuation train from Zaporojie for people with handicap and disabilities. Our daughter has Down Syndrom so we were able to leave Zaporojie. Some volunteers looked after us and guided us to be able to get to Romania, in Dorohoi.

Our family are staying in Casa Neemia, a beautiful house with many rooms where young boys and girls orphans are staying as well. We feel very welcome here, Beni and Angelica are looking after all our needs and all the others are caring, kind and very friendly with us. We are staying now in a large, beautiful and very comfortable room. We are well fed with delicious food every day.


