February 2023

In 2022 AN received goods with a local value of some £49,000 from the UK and acquired additional goods locally to the value of £1,500. Some local goods were received as donations, others were funded by specific sponsorship. Some 2,400 separate donations were made during the year, giving each donation a typical value of £21.

Official statistics issued at the end of January show that some 63% of the Romanian resident population is not active in the national workforce, either because they are too young or are too old. It is these two groups that receive most of the aid that we distribute; pensioners account for 30% of our registered beneficiaries.

In addition to our usual activities we have continued to address the needs of our Ukrainian visitors, and we are grateful for the help that we receive specifically for this purpose.

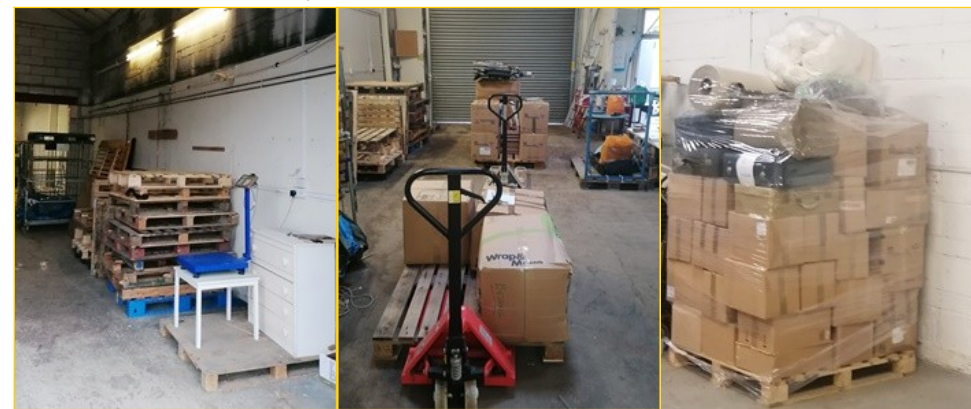
