## Prayer Notes

### July 2024

The Romanian National Institute of Statistics has published a report showing that, in 2023, almost 20% of the resident Romanian population was affected by severe material deprivation. This amounts to some 4million people; the most severely affected group are those households with dependent children, where one-third of the population is living with the risk of poverty or social exclusion.

During June we distributed clothing and household items to 123 household, a rate of about 6 households per day. These items had a total nominal value of £620 - not much in the national context but certainly a benefit to those who received them. In addition we received short-time food valued at £8,500 for donation to particularly needy households.

The national study excluded the benefits of home-grown food and livestock. This can make a significant difference and we try to help people make use of their gardens and land whenever possible.
