Marcel was one of the homeless young men who featured in our early thoughts about providing accommodation for people like him, back in 2015. In due course Casa Neemia was built but he was considered unsuitable for living there due to his social awkwardness and his inability to get on with other people. Now, ten years later, he has matured, become more self-confident and has settled down. Each morning he comes for an hour or so to help move boxes between the warehouse shop and office. His help has become invaluable.

Administrative activities at the office this month have been concentrating on finalising the accounts for 2024. Since 2012 we have been using an in-house accounting system which could promptly provide the details that our accountant needed. However, in 2024, the government stipulated that all traders, including charities, should use designated software, which has proven to be both complex and inflexible. Many hours have been spent in training and efforts to reconcile the two systems.

In Horley, packing continues on the first and third Friday of each month, the next dates are the 20th June, 4th and 18th July. The team meets at Horley Baptist Church from 13:30 to 15:30 on those Fridays.

In Romania we continue to provide help, mainly clothing and food. We currently receive short-dated food worth about £3,500 each month; this requires prompt distribution, to individuals who come to the office and to the residents of Casa Neemia.

Some of our residents have been working at the warehouse, organising the stock and giving our little orchard a tidy-up. This year's crop of maize is beginning to grow, revealing the curved track of the seed drill!
