August 2025

Casa Neemia is currently full, with 7 Romanians and 10 Ukrainians occupying the rooms. In general, they live well together, co-operating in looking after the house and tending its garden and polytunnel.

Some residents from Casa Neemia spent several days at the warehouse making the grounds more presentable. This year we are using the land at the warehouse for growing sunflowers which will be pressed into cooking oil for donation later in the year. There is also a good crop of apples although very few cherries this year.

We have continued to receive food donations from a local supermarket. We have a large fridge and a freezer in the office, to ensure food quality prior to donation. Typically 10 households per day receive food although the number can range between 5 and 25 dependent upon the quantity of items that we receive each day. Occasionally the items include over-stocked vegetables which are no longer suitable for donation as food but they can be used for feeding domestic animals, so nothing is wasted.
